We know that there are many of our union members from across Canada currently filling calls for CLAC. Our goal is for these members do the right thing and quit filling calls for CLAC, forcing the owners to come to 771 to fill calls.

Current jobs:

**BHP, Jansen** – CLAC is using Worley, Aecon, and Ledcor here. This job is under a PLA so our wages are fairly similar, they are offering travel incentives which is the reason they are attracting many of our members. However, we have hours earned on our pension contributions which CLAC does not.

**K+S Legacy, Bethune** – This job is under our full CBA for Local 771. Worley is the main CLAC contractor there and if they can not fill the call for these jobs, these companies will use their union arms to hire from 771.

Anyone you know at these jobs, who is not dispatched from Local 771, is offside and hopefully will do the right thing and leave.
